In addition to the 555 patterns programmed into the KH-930/940/965 knitting machines there are additional patterns permanently programmed into the machine that are not covered in Stitch World. Diagrams are on other side.

885	--	--	<b>Circuit Test:</b> The voltage should be 176 or 192. This test can check the voltage of the left sensor by pushing the "yellow" key for the left and the "green" key for the right. Mis-selection can occur if the wrong numbers appear in the window.
886-887	--	--	Nothing
888	--	--	<b>Memory Test:</b> The computer will test the memory. <b>WARNING!!!</b> all memory of manually programmed designs will be erased!
889	--	--	<b>Display Key Test:</b> 930 = the lights will blink. 940 = the lights will go out and not come back on. This will indicate the function of each key is well connected and that the PC board is functioning.
890-999	--	--	Nothing

**If 888 keeps flashing:** Press the STEP and INPUT buttons at the same time.  
**Warning!!!** all manually programmed designs will be erased!

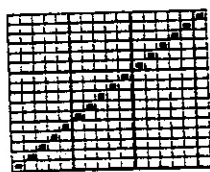
